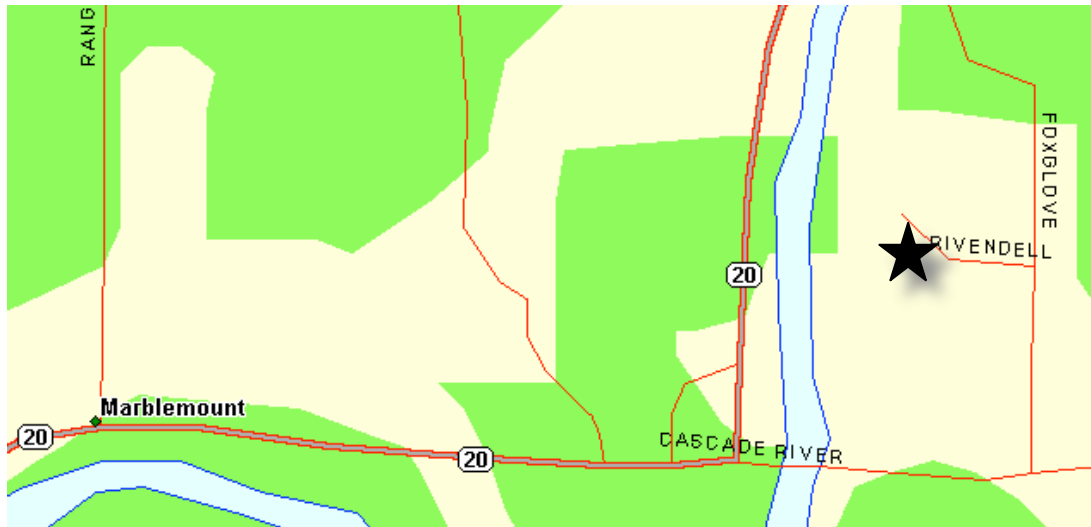


Directions to Our Wedding



From Seattle via Rt 530:

Head north on Interstate 5 to Exit 208: Route 530 (exit also says Arlington). Turn right at the end of the exit. Follow Route 530 for 28 miles to Darrington. Turn left at the only stop sign in Darrington - follow the speed limit of 30 mph. Continue on Hwy 530 for another 19 miles, ends at a "T" intersection with Route 20. Turn right onto Route 20 for about 9 miles. In Marblemount you will see a Shell gas station and the Post Office on the right - go straight across the bridge instead of following Route 20 to the left. In 0.3 mile turn left onto the gravel road Foxglove Lane. Stay under 15 MPH to keep the dust down. At 1/2 mi. you'll see Rivendell Lane. Turn left down the hill and look for the second driveway on the left, house number 60626. Turn left into the driveway. Our phone number is (360) 873-4567.

From Bellingham and points North:

Head south on Interstate 5 to the Cook Road exit #232. Turn East (left) at the end of the ramp. Go about 4 miles; at the red light in Sedro Woolley, turn left onto Hwy 20, following it 45 miles. The speed limit in Concrete is 35 MPH – beware!

In Marblemount you will see a Shell gas station and the Post Office on the right - go straight across the bridge instead of following Route 20 to the left. In 0.3 mile turn left onto the gravel road Foxglove Lane. Stay under 15 MPH to keep the dust down. At 1/2 mi. you'll see Rivendell Lane. Turn left down the hill and look for the second driveway on the left, house number 60626. Turn left into the driveway. Our phone number is (360) 873-4567.

Parking:

We will have a parking helper, but if you show early or late, look for a "more parking" sign. There is room for 25 cars along the fence right before Rivendell Lane. There are also mowed spaces along Rivendell Lane. Our neighbors are kindly offering their driveways. Please use our driveway only for drop-offs and pick-ups, as we have parking for only four cars.
